

24 months

At the 2 year old visit your child will have a routine physical exam, assessment of growth and development, anticipatory guidance and a finger prick blood test to check hemoglobin and lead.

At this visit:

- Full physical exam
- Assessment of growth and development
- Monitoring of developmental milestones such as combining words into short sentences, using utensils to eat
- M-CHAT developmental screening questionnaire
- Ages and Stages Developmental Screening questionnaire
- Anticipatory guidance on topics including diet, development and safety
- Hemoglobin and lead screening
- Immunizations—Hep A (Influenza, if indicated)
